Filipa Fiúza (Cacém, 1988) has completed the Master's Degree in Architecture (2010) in ISCTE-IUL (Lisbon University Institute). She is currently a PhD student (supported by the FCT- Foundation for Science and Technology) on Cultural Heritage of Portuguese Influence at the Centre for Social Studies and Institute for Interdisciplinary Research of the University of Coimbra. Researcher at DINÂMIA'CET-IUL - Centre for Socioeconomic and Territorial Studies, since 2012. Co-IR of the project "Dominance and mass-violence through Housing and Architecture during colonial wars. The Portuguese case (Guinea-Bissau, Angola, Mozambique): colonial documentation and post-independence critical assessment" (PTDC/ART-DAQ/0592/2020), financed by the FCT.
